She received the vision to establish FOJ in March 2017, and members of her immediate household formed the first group of financial contributors. The group has grown over the years, with some other spiritual children of the Visioner volunteering as financial contributors to the project.

The Friends of Jesus' operational structure and modus operandi have evolved over the years under the management of a team of Christian professionals from various walks of life who volunteer their services to ensure the smooth running of the organisation.

All applicants are thoroughly screened and counselled. Standardised processes are adhered to in all engagements with applicants, and unless otherwise approved, scholarships are paid directly to schools, medical bills are settled with health care providers, and house rents are paid directly to landlords or their designated agents.
